During this one-week, resident experience, you will lodge in a motel-style room and volunteer in the maintenance department under the supervision of our Maintenance Host. The Maintenance Host is one of our staff members whose primary responsibility is to lead the volunteer maintenance staff through their week. Together they assist in maintenance responsibilities such as mowing, weed-whacking, trash removal, stocking firewood, setups, painting and more. In addition, a morning and afternoon break allows for some free time and interaction with the other staff and campers. Daily devotions led by the Maintenance Host, along with each night's Vespers service provide opportunities for spiritual growth.
