

a team, through acts of service and humility, we preached and faithfully followed that same example of love—as a community, as a church, as a family: The Black Rock Family.

- 209 volunteers totaling 1,661.5 hours of volunteer work




OUTDOOR EDUCATION


Black Rock's Impact in Action
