Each day includes suggested prayer topics for campers, their siblings, parents, grandparents, donors, and others connected to camp ministry!

Together, we can cover this summer in prayer and ask God to prepare hearts, strengthen families, bless our staff, and work powerfully in the lives of every camper who comes to Black Rock Retreat.

30 Days of PRAYERS that FLIP THE SCRIPT

DAY 1

Old to New

2 Corinthians 5:17

"Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!"

Campers: Pray for your counselors to have excitement for the new summer ahead.

Donors: Pray for former campers in their new life pursuits (college, careers, families, etc.).

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for your kids/grandkids to see the Lord and His Word with new eyes at camp.

Siblings: Pray for your sibling to have fun, new experiences with old and new friends!

DAY 2

Darkness to Light



Ephesians 5:8

"For once you were full of darkness, but now you have light from the Lord. So live as people of light!"

Campers: Pray for your family to live in the light of Jesus every day.

Donors: Pray for any campers who do not know Jesus to begin to live in His light.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for your kids/grandkids to live in the light of Jesus always.

Siblings: Pray that your sibling will share the light of Jesus with others.

DAY 3

Death to Life

John 5:24

"I tell you the truth, those who listen to my message and believe in God who sent me have eternal life. They will never be condemned for their sins, but they have already passed from death into life."

Campers: Pray for your siblings to listen to Jesus and believe in Him so that they can live eternally.

Donors: Pray for the counselors to boldly share Jesus' message with the campers.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for the donors to rejoice in the Truth that they are alive in Christ and set free from death.

Siblings: Pray for all the campers to know Jesus so that they can live with him forever.

DAY 4

Slavery to Freedom



Galatians 5:1

"So Christ has truly set us free. Now make sure that you stay free, and don't get tied up again in slavery to the law."

Campers: Pray for any campers who do not know Christ to be set free from sin.

Donors: Pray for the parents and grandparents of the campers to guide their children to live in Christ's freedom.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for the leadership of Black Rock to lead in Christ's freedom.

Siblings: Pray for your sibling to live in the freedom that only Jesus can give.

DAY 5

Small to Great

Matthew 17:20

"I tell you the truth, if you had faith even as small as a mustard seed, you could say to this mountain, 'Move from here to there,' and it would move. Nothing would be impossible."

Campers: Pray for the leadership of Black Rock to have great faith in what God can do.

Donors: Pray for the summer staff at Black Rock to have great faith in what God will do in them and through them this summer.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for your family to live by faith and trust God to do great things.

Siblings: Pray for your parents and grandparents to put their faith in God for everything they need.

30 Days of PRAYERS that FLIP THE SCRIPT

DAY 6

Least to Greatest

Luke 9:48

"Anyone who welcomes a little child like this on my behalf welcomes me, and anyone who welcomes me also welcomes my Father who sent me. Whoever is the least among you is the greatest."

Campers: Ask God to help you and the other campers to be welcoming to all the kids at camp.

Donors: Pray for everyone at camp to feel that they are valuable and loved by Jesus.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for your kids to know how valuable they are in Christ and feel welcome at camp.

Siblings: Pray for the campers to be welcoming to your sibling.

DAY 7

East to West

Psalm 103:12

"He has removed our sins as far from us as the east is from the west."

Campers: Say a prayer of thanks to the Lord today for forgiving you of all your sins and pray that other campers would know God's forgiveness, too.

Donors: Pray for the counselors to be quick to forgive others as they have been forgiven.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for your kids to be quick to forgive others as they have been forgiven.

Siblings: Say a prayer of thanks to the Lord today for forgiving you of all your sins and pray for all of your family to be thankful for God's forgiveness.

DAY 8

Hidden to Seen

Mark 4:22

"For everything that is hidden will eventually be brought into the open, and every secret will be brought to light."

Campers: Pray for your friends at camp to be truthful with their counselors.

Donors: Pray for the counselors to model honesty and integrity for the campers.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for your kids to be positive peer role models of honesty and integrity.

Siblings: Pray for your sibling to have good role models at camp.



DAY 9

Sickness to Health



Luke 7:21

"At that time Jesus was healing many people of all kinds of sickness and disease and was putting out demons."

Campers: Pray for your counselors to remain healthy and protected from harm.

Donors: Pray for the campers to remain healthy and protected from harm.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for the donors to be blessed with good health and protection from the Lord.

Siblings: Pray for your family to remain healthy and safe.

DAY 10

Night to Day

Psalm 139: 12

"...To you the night shines as bright as day. Darkness and light are the same to you."

Campers: Pray for your counselors to sleep well each night and be refreshed during the day.

Donors: Pray for the families of the campers to sleep well and not worry while their child/sibling is away.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for your kids/grandkids to have peaceful rest at night and refreshed during the day.

Siblings: Pray for your parents to sleep well while your sibling is away at camp.

30 Days of PRAYERS that FLIP THE SCRIPT

DAY 11

Sadness to Joy

John 16:22

"So you have sorrow now, but I will see you again; then you will rejoice, and no one can rob you of that joy."

Campers: Pray for other campers who might be feeling sad to be away from home and ask God to give them joy because Jesus is with them.

Donors: Pray for counselors to have patience and compassion with campers who are experiencing sadness and help them to point the campers to the joy Jesus gives.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for the donors to have joy knowing that they have blessed so many families with their generosity.

Siblings: Pray for your sibling to feel the joy of Jesus at camp.

DAY 12

Empty to Full

John 10:10

"The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full."

Campers: Pray for the kids at camp who don't know Jesus to come to know him and be filled with His Spirit.

Donors: Pray for Black Rock's leadership to thrive in the abundant blessings of knowing Christ.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for your kids to desire to live life to the full in Jesus.

Siblings: Pray for the kids at your sibling's camp who don't know Jesus to come to know him and be filled with His Spirit.



DAY 13

Weak to Strong

2 Corinthians 12:10

"That's why I take pleasure in my weaknesses, and in the insults, hardships, persecutions, and troubles that I suffer for Christ. For when I am weak, then I am strong."

Campers: Pray for counselors to lean on God's strength always.

Donors: Pray for the campers to grow in the strength of the Lord.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for your family to remain strong in the Lord.

Siblings: Pray for your sibling to grow strong in God's strength.



DAY 14

Rough to Smooth



Isaiah 45:2

"I will go before you and make the rough places smooth."

Campers: Pray for daily activities to run smoothly at camp.

Donors: Pray for the Surge Leadership Training to run smoothly.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for life to run smoothly at the homes of the counselors so that they can focus on camp.

Siblings: Pray for all the daily activities to run smoothly for your sibling at camp.

DAY 15

Fear to Faith

Psalms 56:3

"When I am afraid, I put my trust in you."

Campers: Pray for the leadership of Black Rock to put their trust in the Lord and not fear.

Donors: Pray for the campers and their families to trust in the Lord and not be afraid.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for the donors of Black Rock to continue to trust in the Lord and not be afraid.

Siblings: Pray for your parents and grandparents to trust in the Lord and not be afraid.



30 Days of PRAYERS that FLIP THE SCRIPT

DAY 16

Evil to Good

1 Thessalonians 5:15

"See that no one pays back evil for evil, but always try to do good to each other and to all people."

Campers: Pray for the campers to try to do good things to one another.

Donors: Pray for the counselors to do good to the campers, even those who are challenging.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for Christ's goodness to be shown through the staff at Black Rock to every camper.

Siblings: Pray for your siblings to try to do good things to one another always.

DAY 17

Mourning to Dancing



Psalms 30:11

"You have turned my mourning into joyful dancing."

Campers: Pray for Black Rock to be a place where campers can find joy and heal from past hurts..

Donors: Pray for Black Rock to be a place where staff, counselors, and campers can find joy and heal from past hurts.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for Black Rock to be a place where staff, counselors, and campers can find joy and heal from past hurts.

Siblings: Pray that your sibling will share the light of Jesus with others.

DAY 18

Enemy to Friend

Romans 5:10

"For since our friendship with God was restored by the death of his Son while we were still his enemies, we will certainly be saved through the life of his Son."

Campers: Pray for any campers who act like enemies. Ask them to find friendship with God and others.

Donors: Pray for the counselors to have a close friendship with God and model that for the campers.

Parents and Grandparents: Say a prayer of thanks today for the friendship of God, and pray that your child(ren) would always accept God's gift of friendship.

Siblings: Say a prayer of thanks today that God is your friend.

DAY 19

Defeat to Victory

Isaiah 12:2

"See, God has come to save me. I will trust in him and not be afraid. The LORD GOD is my strength and my song; he has given me victory."

Campers: Ask God to help you and all the campers have a great attitude in all your camp activities and not be overly competitive.

Donors: Pray for counselors to work together as a team for the good of all the campers and to the glory of God.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for the leadership of Black Rock to have victory in Christ through every circumstance and never feel defeated in doing good.

Siblings: Pray for your sibling to live in the freedom that only Jesus can give.

DAY 20

Impossible to Possible



Mark 10:27

"...Humanly speaking, it is impossible. But not with God. Everything is possible with God."

Campers: Pray for campers to trust God no matter how hard a problem seems.

Donors: Pray for Black Rock's Capital Campaign to exceed expectations.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for the counselors to trust God with every circumstance they face and believe for Him to provide.

Siblings: Pray for your family to trust God at all times.

DAY 21

Proud to Humble



James 4:10

"Humble yourselves before the Lord, and he will lift you up in honor."

Campers: Pray for your counselors to remain humble before God.

Donors: Pray for Black Rock's leadership to lead with humility.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for God to help you guide your family with humility.

Siblings: Pray for your sibling to be humble before God.

DAY 22

Last to First

Mark 9:35

"He sat down, called the twelve disciples over to him, and said, 'Whoever wants to be first must take last place and be the servant of everyone else.'"

Campers: Pray for your family members to serve others well and always put Christ first

Donors: Pray for the counselors to serve the campers well and put Christ first in their lives.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for the donors and leadership of Black Rock to continue to serve others well and put Christ first.

Siblings: Pray for your sibling to always serve others well and keep Christ first.

DAY 23

Simple to Wise



Psalms 19:72

"The law of the Lord is perfect, refreshing the soul. The statutes of the Lord are trustworthy, making wise the simple."

Campers: Pray that the Lord would make you wise in His wisdom and not in the ways of the world.

Donors: Pray for the families of the campers to love God's Word and be filled with His wisdom..

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for your children to be hungry for God's Word and grow in His wisdom.

Siblings: Pray for the campers to learn God's Word and become wise.

DAY 24

Stormy to Still

Matthew 8:26

"Jesus responded, 'Why are you afraid? You have so little faith!' Then he got up and rebuked the wind and waves, and suddenly there was a great calm."

Campers: Pray for the weather to be great for all of the outdoor activities.

Donors: Pray for the counselors and the storms of life they may be facing. Ask the Lord to calm their storms.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for the donors and the storms of life they may be facing. Ask the Lord to calm their storms.

Siblings: Pray for your family to remain healthy and safe.

DAY 25

Orphaned to Adopted

Romans 8:15

"...you received God's Spirit when he adopted you as his own children. Now we call him, 'Abba, Father.'"

Campers: Pray for any kids at camp who may not have families. Ask God to help them to know they are adopted into His family.

Donors: Pray for Black Rock to always be a place where everyone knows they are part of the family of God.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for campers who are in foster care to know they are loved and adopted in Christ.

Siblings: Pray for all the campers to know they are brothers and sister in Christ.

30 Days of PRAYERS that FLIP THE SCRIPT

DAY 26

Poor to Rich

Job 5:11

"He gives prosperity to the poor and protects those who suffer."

Campers: Pray for God to bless the families of all the campers with everything they need

Donors: Pray for all of the campers who are at Black Rock on scholarships and ask the Lord to continue to meet their family's financial needs.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for Black Rock to thrive financially so that it may continue to be a blessing in the community for generations to come.

Siblings: Say a pray of thanks to God for you all that you have and pray for God to continue to provide for all your family's need.

DAY 27

Curse to Blessing

Luke 6:27-28

"But to you who are willing to listen, I say, love your enemies! Do good to those who hate you. Bless those who curse you. Pray for those who hurt you."

Campers: Pray for God to help you love the campers who can be unkind to you.

Donors: Pray for all of the counselors to help protect campers who are the brunt of other campers not acting kindly. Pray for wisdom for counselors to correct them gently in the Lord.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for the leadership of Black Rock to maintain healthy, Godly standards for a loving, gracious, safe space for all campers at camp.

Siblings: Ask the Lord to bless all the kids at camp with kind friends.

DAY 28

Anxiety to Peace

Philippians 4:6-7

"Do not be anxious about anything, but in every situation, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus."

Campers: Pray for all the campers to feel God's peace at camp.

Donors: Pray for Black Rock to be a place of God's peace for all who enter it.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for the peace of Christ to reign in your home, at Black Rock, and in the hearts and minds of your children and their camp counselors.

Siblings: Pray for peace in your sibling's heart and mind.

DAY 29

Blindness to Sight

Isaiah 35:5

"And when he comes, he will open the eyes of the blind and unplug the ears of the deaf."

Campers: Ask the Lord to give you eyes to see the miracles He is doing at camp and the ears to hear His voice leading you.

Donors: Pray for the camp counselors to have eyes to see and ears to hear the Lord.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for the donors and leadership at Black Rock to have eyes to see and ears to hear the Lord.

Siblings: Pray for your sibling to see God working at camp and hear His voice.

DAY 30

Lost to Found



Luke 15:32

"He was lost, but is found."

Campers: Ask the Lord to help all the campers to feel the Father's love for them as they learn about the Prodigal Son. Pray for all who are lost to be found in Christ.

Donors: Pray for the counselors to feel the Father's relentless love as they teach the campers about the Prodigal Son.

Parents and Grandparents: Pray for you children to understand the Father's love as they learn about the Prodigal Son.

Siblings: Pray for the campers to know how much God loves them.
